

THE STORY OF A PARADIGM SHIFTING SCHOOL

La Paz Community School was founded in 2007 in order to address the socio-cultural challenges and gaps of a region with an agricultural and touristic economy. By integrating young people from various cultures and socioeconomic levels, La Paz transforms diversity into strengths. The educational model of La Paz differentiates itself through its communitarian vocation and forward-looking approach. Families, teachers and the community at large represent the socioeconomic and cultural diversity of Guanacaste and the world, while being part of a learning laboratory and benefiting from a rigorous program rooted in the mission, peace practices, and attributes of the IB learner. During their school life, La Paz students dedicate time, talent, energy and other resources to carry out projects benefiting the local and global community, and preparing them to become active and responsible citizens. In 2021, the new campus in Tempisque was inaugurated with the goal to expand the educational and sociocultural impact of La Paz in the province of Guanacaste.

GRADING SYSTEM

The La Paz grading system rewards the process as well as the product of the learning experience. La Paz student GPAs are based on a 0-4 scale where a 4 is not the equivalent of an A+, 100%, or 4.0 in traditional grading scales. The La Paz student understands that achieving an exemplary mark signifies that they have not only demonstrated mastery of higher order thinking skills but they have also creatively developed an entirely unique and rational thought, connection, idea or innovation during the learning process.
